March shines one of the largest, brightest spotlights cabaret has ever seen when the city celebrates Chicago Cabaret Week as part of its 2020 Year of Chicago Music: Music in the Key of Chicago. Chicago Cabaret Week has over 45 shows at 18 venues across 11 days! As Gershwin so aptly put it, who could ask for anything more?

The schedule highlights the rich diversity of cabaret styles. Catch Scott Gryder for hilarity (PianoForte, 3/20), Anne and Mark Burnell's Julie London tribute on the jazz side (Green Mill, 3/25), Hilary Ann Feldman's feats of storytelling in *Laughing Matters of Carol Burnett* (Davenport's, 3/25), Joan Curto's Broadway swagger in *Everybody Says Don't: The Music of Stephen Sondheim*, or the interactive fun of *The Nitz & Howe Experience* (Davenport's, 3/28). There are so many more; check out the full schedule (chicagocabaretweek.org).

This embarrassment of riches offers a unique opportunity for both the cabaret aficionado to see some of their favorite acts and the newcomer to sample a broad menu of performances for the low price of \$25, \$15, or less. The chance to see so many world-class performers in such a short period of time is one any lover of music in intimate settings should not miss.
